

# Etihad Airways Group CO2 Emission Targets

## Introduction

In line with increasing worldwide concern about the impact of carbon emissions on global climate patterns, to underline its commitment to the aviation industry's plans for CO2 reduction (CORSIA), and to support the UN Sustainable Development Goals, EAG will adopt new targets for operational CO2 emission with immediate effect. We will announce this new policy in conjunction with our Eco-flight to Brussels on January 13th 2020. The initiative is in line with the UAE Government's theme for its 2020 Vision for the next 50 years.

## Policy Statement

Etihad Aviation Group is committed with immediate effect to minimum targets for net CO2 emissions for its aircraft operations as follows:

- By 31 December 2035 – a 50% reduction in net CO2 emissions vs. 2019 levels
- By 31 December 2050 – zero net carbon emissions

The overall action plan and performance tracking will be the responsibility of the Sustainability Team.


