EAG – SINGLE-USE PLASTICS POLICY

Introduction

In line with increasing worldwide concern about the impact of single-use plastic pollution, as well as new laws restricting their use, EAG will adopt a new policy to substantially reduce single-use plastics across the business with immediate effect.

We will announce this new policy in conjunction with our single-use plastic free flight to Brisbane on 21 April 2019 to demonstrate the Group's long term commitment to driving change.

The initiative is in line with the Abu Dhabi Government's new single-use plastic phase out policy.

Policy Statement

Etihad Aviation Group is committed, with immediate effect, to reduce the use of single-use plastics across the business, with a target of an 80 per cent reduction by the end of 2022.

To achieve this, the sustainability team will work with all EAG business units responsible for in-flight services, ground operations, engineering, commercial and office facilities management, to identify current uses of single-use plastics and to recommend commercially viable replacement materials that can be reused and/or recycled.

The overall action plan and performance tracking will be the responsibility of the sustainability team.
